Occasionally I am asked, "What can I (we) do to strengthen our faith and help the church grow?" I've been praying about this lately and here is my reply:

THE CHURCH: BE ALL IN

Be the Church: There are many ways you can "be" the church. First, make a commitment to be more active in worship. If you normally come once a month, start with twice a month.
