

All money and clothing items donated need to be turned in to the church no later than July 31<sub>st</sub>. We will then take those funds to buy the supplies. On August 14<sub>th</sub>, we will organize all the supplies on tables for families to come pick up for free. We will need help distributing the items out on the tables and serving the families that come in to get them. This is a great way to reach families in the area who may not have a church family.
