Beverly Junker Youth Music Scholarship: St. Peter's UCC in Grant Park is committed to encouraging and financially supporting students as they enhance their skills and love of music/fine arts activities.

Turkey Supper and Raffle: November 4th is almost here. We still need many servers, people in the pie room, return foods and dishwashers, carry outs, and kitchen workers during the event.
