

Just this past weekend, the women's 400-meter hurdles world record was broken at the World Athletics Championships by Sydney McLaughlin.

Her time of 50.68 broke her previous record as she became the first female athlete to post a time of under 51 seconds in the event.

Following her race, like so many other athletes before, she offered all the credit to her Savior and said that she was "in awe of God."
