## **Back to School Supply Drive**

We have organized a “Back to School Supply Drive” for the elementary kids (Preschool-5<sup>th</sup> grade) here in Grant Park. With prices still going up, it’s harder for families to afford the things their children need for school. This drive not only helps our GP families, but helps the teachers who buy some supplies out of their pockets so the children have what they need.

We need your help! We would like to gather supplies and raise funds to be able to purchase school items the kids need. If you want to purchase some items yourself, we are also looking for brand new or like new (no stains or signs of wear) clothes to wear to school. The kids will also need t-shirts for painting, new socks and new shoes for gym, and durable backpacks (some big enough to fit chrome books for the older kids). We are also in need of huge quantities of pencils (packs of 6, 20, and 24), glue sticks, and dry erase markers (black or black fine tip). All money, clothing, and supply items donated need to be turned in to the church no later than July 31<sup>st</sup>. We will then take those funds to buy the supplies. On August 14<sup>th</sup>, we will organize all the supplies on tables for families to come pick up for free.
