Scripture Reading (1st Reading)

Exodus 3:1-6 (NIV)

- **3** Moses was keeping the flock of his father-in-law, Jethro, the priest of Midian; he led his flock beyond the wilderness, and came to Horeb, the mountain of God.
- ² There, the angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire out of a bush; he looked, and the bush was blazing, yet it was not consumed.
- ³ Then Moses said, "I must turn aside and look at this great sight, and see why the bush is not burned up."
- ⁴When the LORD saw that he had turned aside to see, God called to him out of the bush, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am."
- ⁵ Then he said, "Come no closer! Remove the sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground."
- ⁶He said further, "I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God.

Scripture Reading (2nd **Reading**)

Exodus 33:12-23 (NIV)

¹² Moses said to the LORD, "See, you have said to me, 'Bring up this people'; but you have not let me know whom you will send with me. Yet, you have said, 'I know you by name, and you have also found favor in my sight.' ¹³ Now if I have found favor in your sight, show me your ways, so that I may know you and find favor in your sight. Consider, too, that this nation is your people." ¹⁴ He said, "My presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." ¹⁵ And he said to Him, "If your presence will not go, do not carry us up from here. ¹⁶ For how shall it be known that I have found favor in your sight, I and your people, unless you go with us? In this way, we shall be distinct, I and your people, from every people on the face of the earth."

¹⁷ The LORD said to Moses, "I will do the very thing that you have asked; for you have found favor in my sight, and I know you by name." ¹⁸ Moses said, "Show me your glory, I pray." ¹⁹ And He said, "I will make all My goodness pass before you, and will proclaim before you the name, 'The LORD'; ^[a] and I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy. ²⁰ But," He said, "you cannot see My face; for no one shall see Me and live." ²¹ And the LORD continued, "See, there is a place by Me where you shall stand on the rock; ²² and while My glory passes by, I will put you in a cleft of the rock and I will cover you with My hand until I have passed by; ²³ then I will take away My hand, and you shall see My back; but My face shall not be seen."
