Be on the LOOK-OUT



All members should be receiving a letter from the church council within the first few days of May.

Due to COVID-19 keeping us from meeting together, and with a policy of having a congregational meeting when we need to approve a purchase of over \$5,000, the church council thought the urgent need should be handled via a letter and a returned ballot.

The letter will explain the dire need of replacing the church roof and some updates to the eastside of the building.

Each letter will contain a ballot (per person/member) in your household. If there is an error in our tally, please simply write down the names of each member on the ballot and their choice for the vote.

Additionally, a return envelope already stamped will be provided along with another envelope for your financial gift to help pay for the roof.

We ask that you quickly fill it out and return it as we would like replies by May 8th. If you have a question or can't get it in the mail before that, please give the church a call (815) 465-6191 and you can register your vote with Marcia or Pastor Kyle over the phone (though we'd strongly prefer your mail-in vote).

<u>Re-Opening St. Peter's UCC</u>

The Church Council discussed and decided during the April meeting its goal of setting forth a date of Sunday, June 7th for our first gathering since the COVID-19 shutdown.

We want to express to each of you that we have set forth a plan to prepare for how things will look that Sunday, and beyond, as we aim for a safe environment for all.

Our commitment to you includes:

- A major cleaning of the sanctuary, entry ways, bathrooms, hallways, and any areas that people will be congregating. This will take place prior to June 7th and we will provide deeper cleaning after each service.
- A handful of handmade facemasks will be available for those who do not have one. If the state order is that indoor gatherings need to have facemasks worn then that will be our expectation. If you do not feel like you can wear one during the service we encourage you to stay at home and enjoy our online services.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available at each entry/exit and in other areas around the church.

Other things to be aware of (possibilities):

- Pews will be roped off (every other pew) to encourage social distancing. We ask you to sit with your couple/family but respect spaces to the left/right of where others are already seated.
- The choir section will be available for some seating as well.
- If capacity of seating appears to be full, we may consider adding an extra service throughout the summer (we'll have to wait and see how attendance is).
- Service will begin at 9 am.

- There will be no greeters if you need assistance with the church elevator/lift, please let the Council Representative know and we'll provide help.
- There will be no bulletins (with the exception of maybe a few on given Sundays if reading/song singing is required)
- We will probably not be singing as a congregation (could change). Most likely a special piano/organ/other special musical pieces will be available.
- There will be no children's sermon until restrictions lift.
- We will not pass offering plates. A plate will be available in different areas of the sanctuary if you want to give that way.
- We will not participate in communion (except when the Pastor leads it on our behalf) until restrictions lift.
- Therefore, a service will likely consist of a prelude, an opening prayer, Scripture Reading, a special musical piece, pastoral prayer, sermon, and benediction That means services will probably be shorter (but I'm not hearing any complaints from any of you smile).

Again, things are always subject to change as Council will examine the situation during its May 19th meeting to assess that we are able to proceed.

Yes, things will look and feel different – but different is okay. We are also open to any ideas/suggestions along the way. We're learning as we go.
