


If you haven't received the news, I announced in early April that I have accepted a new call to ministry in Waterloo, IL. The opportunity is exciting, yet, there is a bitter-sweet feeling in my heart knowing the relationships we've built and the ministry that has been invested in over the past six years is soon to be complete on my end in a few months.

This does not mean the ministry at St. Peter's is complete! Some things to remember as the future transition takes place:

- 1. God is with St. Peter's at all times! Hebrews 13:5 promises that no one is forsaken or forgotten. While pastors come and go, the presence of God is more vital to the life of a church than any pastor.

St. Peter's UCC (Grant Park, IL)

In November, Pastor Kyle presented a sermon titled, "Keep Our Story Growing." On behalf of the church council, he presented a 25/25 challenge for the 2025 calendar year. Most of you should have received a mailing with more information about the challenge. If you did not, please feel free to ask for a copy of the letter.

As of the time of this writing, we've received six responses back. Four have pledged to add \$25 extra a week to their giving, one is pledging an additional \$15/week, and another an extra \$50/month. That's an extra \$6,580 for the year! Imagine how much more we can still receive.

This is encouraging as the pledge cards are just starting to come in. *Reminder – if you haven't sent yours in, please do so!

Also, please note, if you are planning on making an end-of-year financial gift to the church, please do so before December 31st.

Newsletter items need to be submitted prior to the 25th of each month (or the Thursday just before the 25th if it falls on the weekend). Announcements

<u>Help Needed:</u> St. Peter's needs a few people to help in a variety of ways. If you are interested in helping in any of the areas, please contact the church office. Each area of service does not take a lot of time, or training, but are vital in keeping the ministries of our church going.

Audio/Sound System: We need an individual, or two, to learn the basics of turning on and adjusting the sound for our microphones.

Facebook Live Streaming: An individual, or two, that can log in to our St. Peter's facebook page 5 to 10 minutes before each service and press live stream. If willing, to move the camera/stand to record each person/choir/etc. participating in the service. Finally, someone to press "finalize" on the ipad at the conclusion of the service.

Funeral Planning & Information Form: Most of us don't want to talk about dying; however, like taxes, it is inevitable. While many individuals pre-plan their funeral arrangements with a funeral home, cemetery, and/or attorney, we believe it could also be a relief for your loved ones if your plans for the service were also on file. This saves them from the stress of planning it themselves. We have Funeral Information Forms available at the church office or they are located on the church website at https://stpetersgp.org/funeral-pre-planning/ Feel free to pick up or print a copy and fill it out. You may want to leave it with your family in a known location at your home and/or leave a copy with the church office to keep on file. It's never a bad idea to be prepared in life or in death. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask.

Girl Scouts: Did you know that our local Girl Scouts meet at the church on Friday afternoons? If you have a daughter that would like to be part of their group, please contact the church office for more information.

Zion UCC in Dyer: Zion UCC is having their annual Tea Party on May 17th from 12 p.m. to 2 p.m. Kids of all ages are welcome to come to this free event. They will have a Story Teller here also. For more information, please contact the church.

Beverly Junker Youth Music Scholarship: St. Peter's UCC in Grant Park is committed to encouraging and financially supporting students as they enhance their skills and love of music/fine arts activities. The Beverly Junker Scholarship may be used to attend a music camp, musical lessons, or toward fees associated with music related expenses (i.e. instrument, etc.). Scholarships up to \$150 will be awarded based on availability and submission guidelines, and will be available to students entering grades 4-12. Students must be currently studying music in some capacity. Students will complete a scholarship application and submit it to St. Peter's UCC for consideration. Students should be a member of St. Peter's, but not necessary. Consideration towards St. Peter's members will be a priority, along with students who attend worship and youth activities. Students may earn the scholarship a maximum of two times. To apply, contact stpetersgp@sbcglobal.net for a copy of the application form.

Social Hall Rental Policy: If you are interested in renting the social hall, the cost is \$50 for the rental and \$40 for the custodial fee for members. Non-members would pay \$150 with a \$75 custodial fee.
