I have witnessed so many clergy, in our denomination and others, try to change the gospel to fit our desires, agenda, and culture. It is scary. The Word of God wasn't written for the Americans, it was written for a lost world of hurting and lonely people.

Is following Jesus really an easy thing to do? It seems like it among many people I know. Throw a cross necklace on around your neck, show up to church one Sunday a week (or twice a month), make sure you give an offering here and there and boom...you must be a Christian.

Well, Platt reminds us that it isn't that easy.

I encourage (and challenge you) to pick up a copy of this book (or others of his) and read it, pray about it, and then come and tell me what you think.

If you aren't on at the time of the service, that is okay as well. You can go to the church facebook page at any time and scroll through the posts to watch the previously recorded services.

Also known as Basic Support, our contributions support God's mission in the Illinois Conference, nationally, and globally. 71% of our contribution stays in Illinois to carry out the mission of the Illinois Conference. Part of that mission is the support of local church pastors and the local churches, helping local churches during the search and call process, and providing intervention teams to help local churches work through times of challenge.

We contribute \$1,008.33 each month to OCWM through our budget.
