# **Updated Worship Service Info**

- The last Sunday of 9 am worship will be September 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Beginning September 13<sup>th</sup> we will worship at 10:30 am.

**Location**: Outside (weather permitting). Otherwise, please note we will move indoors. Bring your own lawn chairs or blankets.

Please reserve parking spaces nearest the grass area for those who wish to remain in their vehicles.

**<u>Communion</u>**: We will be participating in the Lord's Supper the first Sunday of the month with a few guidelines in place for your protection.

- (1) A disposable cup, with lid, will be provided with a piece of bread/cracker. These will be prepared in advance by someone who has had their temperature checked, is wearing gloves, and wearing a mask.
- (2) The same with the "cup" with grape juice/wine.
- (3) Communion elements can be picked up by each individual prior to the service at one of the tables in the parking lot (or in the sanctuary if we are indoors).
- (4) If you do not feel comfortable participating we totally understand.

<u>Mask Requirements</u>: We are still requiring individuals to wear a mask when entering and exiting the building. Also, anytime you are walking around, a mask needs to be worn. We know that wearing a mask can feel uncomfortable, but so does wearing pants – and trust me, we all want Pastor Kyle to wear his pants each week.

Remember, this is about showing kindness and respect to others who are vulnerable. Worship is about glorifying God and serving others – not our own "feelings" and "opinions."
