

Beverly Junker Youth Music Scholarship: St. Peter's UCC in Grant Park is committed to encouraging and financially supporting students as they enhance their skills and love of music/fine arts activities. The Beverly Junker Scholarship may be used to attend a music camp, musical lessons, or toward fees associated with a music related expense (i.e. instrument, etc.). Scholarships up to \$150 will be awarded based on availability and submission guidelines, and will be available to students entering grades 4-12. Students must be currently studying music in some capacity. Students will complete a scholarship application and submit it to St. Peter's UCC for consideration. Students should be a member of St. Peter's, but not necessary. Consideration towards St. Peter's members will be a priority, along with students who attend worship and youth activities. # **Turkey Supper and Raffle**

Groceries need to be carried in, sweet potatoes need prepared, tables need to be set up/buckets for peeling potatoes, coffee pots and lemonade coolers need washed, the serving room needs set up for coffee, drinks, etc., bread needs to be cut for dressing, the kitchen needs to be cleaned and organized, the dessert room and seating rooms need to be set up, sausage needs to be fried, and cardboard needs to be put on the kitchen and lounge floors.

As always, we need about 50 turkey roasters and about 50 desserts (9X12 dishes).

We are in need of about 30 workers on Friday, November 4<sup>th</sup>, starting at 8:30 a.m. Come and go as you can. There will be a lot of food preparation. We also need about 10 turkey carvers for Saturday morning, November 5<sup>th</sup>, along with as many workers as possible to finish the food prep. We need many servers, people in the pie room, return foods and dishwashers, carry outs, and kitchen workers during the event.

We are also in need of raffle basket items. This has become a huge money maker for us in recent years. We like to raise some money to buy some more big ticket items, along with some baskets.
